1. Listened to: Chairman of the Academic Committee for EP Residency Kurmanalina G.L., who presented data on the preparation for the IGA of residents. She noted the need to conduct trial testing using our own database of test tasks, passing trial self-assessments using the NCNE database, and preparing a CIS for the second stage of the IGA.

1. Speakers: Head of the Department of Neurology, Associate Professor Utepkalieva A.P., noted the need to continue and strengthen preparation for the IGA of residents

1. Decided: continue and strengthen preparation for the IGA of residents

2. Listened to: Chairman of the AC for EP residency Kurmanalina G.L., who presented for discussion the issues of preparation for post-accreditation monitoring, which will take place on May 24, 2023 in an online format

2. Speakers: Head of the Department of Internal Medicine No. 1 Bazargaliev E.Sh. noted that the preparation for post-accreditation monitoring is satisfactory.

2. Decided: prepare supporting documents for post-accreditation monitoring

2 (1). Listened to: Chairman of the AC for EP residency Kurmanalina G.L., who presented for discussion issues of preparation for entrance exams. Entrance exams are offered in oral format with the preparation of situational tasks. She provided a sample checklist and answer sheet.

2 (1). Speakers: Head of the Department of Childhood Diseases No. 1 Professor Zhumalina A.K., who proposed to intensify the work and prepare 20 situational tasks at the internship level for continuing OPDs and prepare 10 situational tasks for new OPDs.

2 (1). Decided: Continue working on preparing for entrance exams. Approve the need to prepare 20 situational tasks with 4 questions for continuing OPDs and 10 situational tasks with 4 questions for new OPDs. Prepare tasks in the approved format with footers. Approve the general format of the checklist and answer sheet, however, specialties can adapt the checklist at their discretion.

2(2). Listened to: Deputy Chairman of the AC for EP Residency Ermagambetova A.P., who presented data on the holding of competitions among residents. Competitions among residents were held in "Adult and Pediatric Neurology", "Neonatology", "Pediatric Surgery"

2 (2). Speakers: Associate Professor of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology Akimzhanov N.A., who noted the need to hold a competition among residents in order to increase motivation for learning.

2 (2). Decided: continue holding competitions among residents

2. (3) Listened to: Chairman of the Academic Committee for EP Residency G.L. Kurmanalina, who presented data on preparation for the interim (annual) transfer certification of residents. She noted the need to prepare a CIS for the interim (annual) transfer certification of residents.
